

All Star Game

- 1 A player must meet all league rules for eligibility, be on his team's final roster as listed by the June 20th cut-off date, and be selected by his teammates.
 - 2 The All-Star Game will be nine innings. Extra innings will be played in the event of a tie.
 - 3 All players except pitchers must play no fewer than three innings or more than six innings unless the game goes into extra innings or injury to a player occurs.
In these cases the maximum number of innings will be waived.
 - 4 Pitchers will play no less than one-third or more than three innings except in cases of extra innings or injury. In these cases the maximum number of innings will be waived.
 - 5 Two players excluding pitchers will represent each team.
 - 6 The All-Star Game managers will select pitchers.
 - 7 The highest place managers from each division will be managers of the All Star Teams.
If one of these managers cannot participate the next available manager (3rd place, 4th place, etc) will replace him.
- * On a trial basis the All-Star teams will be chosen by rankings as of July 4th weekend.
Each team will be assigned a 1 or 2 throughout the league to make up the teams.
